CURRICULUM & INSTRUCTION REPORT  
June 13, 2016**

**Overview of 1:1 Implementation-** I have included an overview of the timeline of what we are doing to prepare for the rollout of our 1:1 initiative.

**Digital Citizenship Curriculum-** Technology committee members from each building met the week after school was out and worked on developing a plan for implementing the Common Sense Media curriculum in each building. I have included a copy of the plans for each building. This curriculum will be taught during the first few weeks of school. The high school and middle school teachers will implement this curriculum during SOAR time and elementary teachers will implement this curriculum in their homerooms. Scoring guides have also been developed to measure each student's competence on using digital citizenship and that will be reported on students' progress reports. The scoring guides are also attached.

**ISTE Standards-** The technology standards are in the process of being revised and final standards are expected to be adopted in July. I have attached a copy of the proposed new standards. We are planning to have our technology committee members meet in July to develop a list of activities for each grade level for each standard that is appropriate for that grade level. These standards will be incorporated through our content areas.

**Professional Development-** We have developed a document that contains several levels of technology proficiency for staff and a timeline for completion. All teachers must demonstrate their competency in the first three levels prior to the start of the school year. I have included a copy of this document and Mrs. Dorrell Murray, Technology Instructional Coach, will discuss the process we are using to measure teacher competency on the skills.
