Be Prepared: New Meal Benefit Form Is Out Now

Free meals for all students throughout the last couple of school years were a welcome relief during the COVID-19 pandemic, however the program which provided funding for these meals has expired. Normal meal charges will resume with the new school year, beginning the first day of school. Prices can be found on our website. If you filled out a form last year and your family qualified for free or reduced meals, there is a grace period through October 6, 2022, during which your child will contin-

ue to receive those benefits, however we recommend filling out the 2022-2023 form as soon as possible because it does take time to process. If your family received a letter stating you have already been qualified (these went out at the end of July), there is no need to fill out a form. We encourage everyone else to scan the QR code



and fill out a Free/Reduced Meal Form now to find out if your family qualifies for benefits. It's easy, and in addition to lowering (or eliminating) meal prices and fees for your family, it helps the district qualify for special programs.
