OVERVIEW OF 1:1 TECHNOLOGY IMPLEMENTATION
2016-2017

April-July	Technology Committee develops procedures for student use of technology that will be outlined in each building's handbook.
May-Aug. 17	Teachers demonstrate proficiency on the first three levels of the staff technology professional development plan.
July	Technology Committee members develop a list of suggested activities aligned to each ISTE technology standard by grade level.
August 11	Common Sense Media training for teachers. Review building plans and scoring guides for all grade level.
August 24	Safety Social Media presentation to students in grades 6-12. Teacher training available after school.
August/Sept.	Parent information provided through school events, parent meetings, website and handbooks. Information about the parent portion of the Common Sense Media curriculum will be provided.
Aug./May	The district instructional technology coach will provide training and support for teachers to integrate technology resources and some PD days will be designated for technology training. Staff surveys will be conducted following the technology PD days. District Technology Committee will analyze results of the surveys and discuss the progress on the 1:1 implementation.
August/Sept.	Each building will teach the Common Sense Media units on digital citizenship and measure student proficiency.
August/May	Integrate technology standards throughout the content areas as appropriate.
January 4	Teachers demonstrate proficiency on the next two levels of the staff professional development plan.
February	Community technology meeting will be held to gain input on technology initiative.
March	Technology committee will report to the Board per the perpetual Board calendar.
